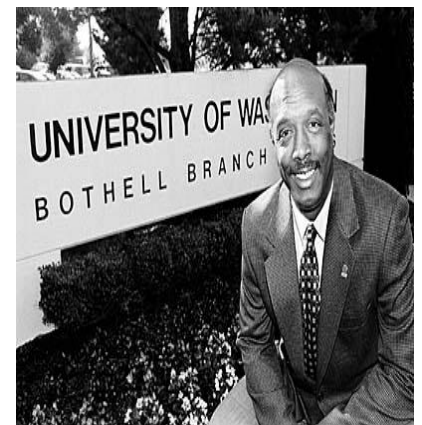

Hotep ACECC Parents/Guardians,

It is time to begin our work on the school's Science Fair! The final Science Project is due Wednesday, February 8<sup>th</sup>, but projects will be accepted beginning Monday, January 9<sup>th</sup>. Late projects will not be accepted. This following will be included in the information packet provided 10/20/11:

- Schedule/Timeline
- Parent/Guardian Acknowledgment Form
- Science Project Proposal Form
- Science Fair Strategies For Teachers and Parents
- Science Paper Outline and Format

Science Projects are required to be turned in, displayed, graded and judged. The first place winner for each grade level will be submitted into the Greater Kansas City Science and Engineering Fair. The Science Project is a major project and is considered a significant portion of the scholar's grade for the next grading period. The primary objective of this project is to have scholar's approach a problem scientifically. This includes:

- Asking questions and forming hypotheses
- Creating experiments to test those hypotheses
- Organizing data and drawing conclusions

Each project will require:

- Parental/guardian assistance at home is required (All projects are finished at home.)
- Science Boards will be ordered by the school for \$5.00 in the identified grade level color (Money will be collected at the Parent/Professor Conferences 10/20/11 and packets provided.)
- Flash drive (Scholars will use the drives to save information on their projects. There will be a few things professors will work with scholars on during the next few months.)

Lastly, parents and guardians can earn **volunteer hours** for helping with the science fair. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact your scholar's professor. **Remember, the timeline should help keep scholars and parents organized and on track form a successful science fair project!**

- Monday, January 9<sup>th</sup> Scholars review of literature and type paper  
Paper Due: Friday, January 20<sup>th</sup>
- Monday, January 16<sup>th</sup> Scholars work on display boards  
Due: Wednesday, January 25<sup>th</sup>
- Wednesday, January 25<sup>th</sup> Boards completed and turned in to Science Professors
